What stuff do I need to do it? Paper, pencil, and a pen or marker.

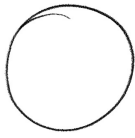
When we read "Floor Juice," by a kid named Ayana from California, we had one thought: what would the juice look like when it hit the floor? And how should we draw it??

For the answers to both questions, please check out the chart on the next page, which we've titled "How to Draw a Splat."

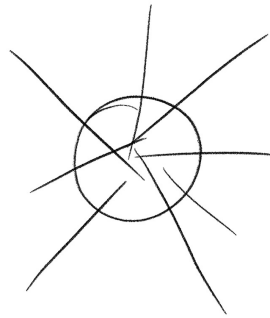
Once you've taken a look...draw some messy splats! And then share them with us!

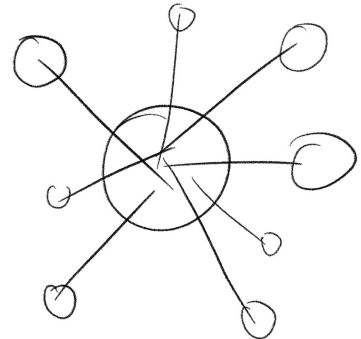
How To Draw A Splat



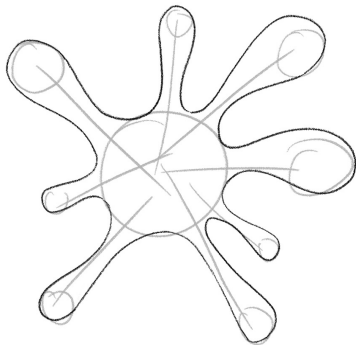
1 Using pencil, lightly draw a circle. This circle will be the center of your splat. It does NOT need to be a perfect circle.



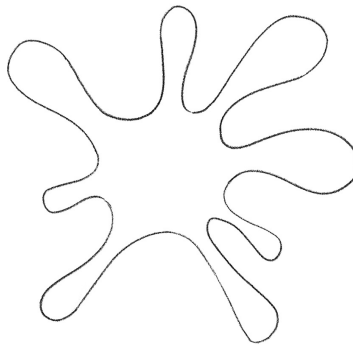
2 Draw some lines coming out of the center of the circle. Make those lines different lengths.



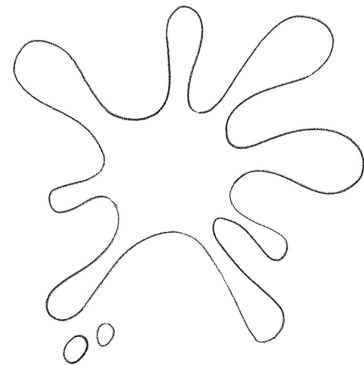
3 Draw circles on the end of each line. Make those circles different sizes.



4 Trace around your shape, connecting the smaller circles to the center circle using curves. Once you've traced the splat outline, go over it in pen.



5 Erase the pencil marks from steps 1-3, leaving behind the splat you traced in step 4.



6 (Optional) Draw small ovals to add extra splatter to the mess you've created.

Experiment and see what happens when you change the size of the center circle, or make the lines longer or shorter!
