Season 3, Episode 17: Minnie, the Cutest Dog in the World / How to Be Give it a Listen: a Great Salesperson

What's this activity about? Learning new vocabulary words and using them to write a story!

What stuff do I need to do it? Pen or pencil and your Creator Club notebook

In her story, "How to Be a Great Salesperson," Ella used a variety of vocabulary words. We thought it would be fun to get new stories using the same words! There are a few kinds of words on the list, and they are used differently:

Noun: a person, place, thing, or idea. Ex: *Joe, field, apple,* and *idea*

Adjective: a word that describes a noun. Ex: Tall, grassy, red, and profound **Verb:** an action word, or something you can do. Ex: Run, grow, crunch, and think

Adverb: a word that describes a verb or adjective that often ends in -ly. Ex: Quickly, softly, loudly, and very

Take a look at the words below, pick a few words that you like the sound of, then put them into any kind of story you want! Maybe you'll write about a glamorous character, or an aggressive villain, or a variety of mishaps! If you want to hear more about how Ella used them in her story, be sure to listen to Lee interviewing her on the podcast.

Glamorous- (adjective) - fancy and beautiful

Meghan was a **glamorous** actress who appeared on magazine covers in her dreams.

Aggressive: (adjective) - forceful

Peter's stomach growl was **aggressive** when the snack table rolled out.

Eliminate - (verb) - to get rid of

Siegfried wanted to **eliminate** all of the snow in his driveway with Snowtung, his axe/snow shovel.

Hazy - (adjective) - unclear or foggy

Lee told all the Story Pirates that they had to wear lemons as hats, but his reasoning was...hazy.

Variety - (noun) - a group of lots of different kinds of things

Creator Club members use a **variety** of vocabulary to write their stories.

Linger- (verb) - to stay for longer than expected

As Loofah **lingered** on the ship, the less the Pirates were scared of her, and the more they liked her!

Deceive- (verb) - to trick or lie to someone

Don't be **deceived:** Baby with a Mustache is not an adult, but a baby!

Mishap (noun) - an accident

Due to a series of **mishaps**, the Story Pirates are now floating aimlessly in space.

Confidence (noun) - belief in yourself

During Rolo's karaoke night, Nimene sang with such confidence that everyone was impressed.
