What's this activity about? Using a shape to inspire a creative drawing.

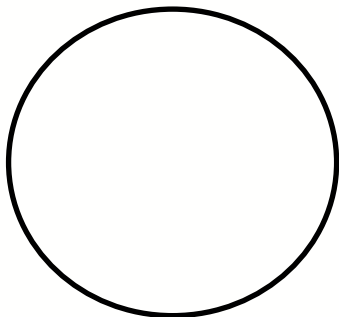
What stuff do I need to do it? Paper and something to draw with.

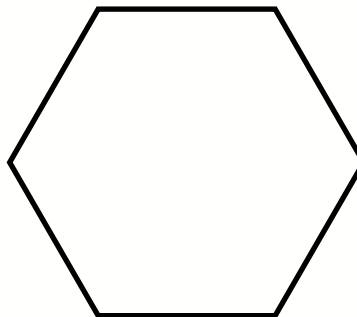

Choose one of the shapes below, and draw it on a blank sheet of paper. Then, draw a picture inside. Grownups can share your work with us!

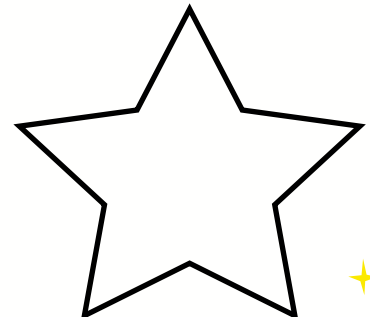
Circle!
